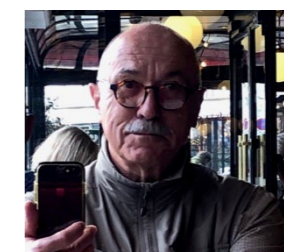

Auf der Maur has presented this underground world in his book "Switzerland Underground". The author was also concerned to draw attention to the enormous sacrifices made by the miners and their families to achieve this gigantic work underground. Jost Auf der Maur grew up in St. Gallen. He was a monastery student, night watchman, temporary letter carrier, parachutist and sturgeon cook. For more than 40 years he worked as an editor and author for various media such as "NZZ", "Geo", "Du" and "Die Zeit". With his books "Mainland," "Mercenaries for Europe," "Xavier Mertz, Lost in Antarctica" and "Switzerland Under Day," Auf der Maur has made a name for himself as an author, and has received several awards for his work."</p>
